The retreat committee (Terry M, Dawn L, Tom S) will be meeting in the next weeks to organize things for the October retreat. The manager for the retreat (Joy N) and teachers will be invited also.
- Everyone thought the June social gathering was very successful and we should do something similar (perhaps at someone else's house) this Fall (Oct?)
- Lou W has had little success in a search for a licensed caregiver to provide child care for those who'd like to attend the Sunday meeting. There was discussion on several ideas like trying to rent some space near Harmony as well as using volunteers from the sangha. Nothing was decided, but all seemed to agree it was worth pursuing further.
- There was discussion how to make decisions when outside groups send IMA2 information about their activities. What should guide us whether we post something on our web site? One suggestion which appealed was to limit postings to those about outside speakers coming to AA and not regular activities like classes or retreats. No one wanted a rigid policy and everyone expressed support for the current ad hoc approach with occasional input from the community.

The Midwest Buddhist Meditation Center has asked if IMA2 would like to be a named participating organization for this year's Walk to Feed the Hungry for Buddhist Global Relief (Sep 27). Everyone agreed this is well within the goals of IMA2 and so we agreed.
